

**AFFIDAVIT
DECLARING DOMESTIC PARTNER RELATIONSHIP FOR
THE DODEA TRANSFER PROGRAM
SCHOOL YEAR 2012-2013**

Definition of Domestic Partners:

Domestic partners are two people who are not married to each other in the traditional sense, who are living together, who have an exclusive and financial commitment to each other, and whose public and private conduct is typical of life partners. Roommates, friends or relatives of any kind are excluded from this definition.

Applicable Criteria:

- (1) Both adults in the relationship are legally free to enter in the relationship (not married to anyone else).
- (2) The relationship is exclusive. Neither party has a similar relationship with another person.
- (3) The employee has been living with his/her domestic partner for at least one (1) year.

The undersigned, for the purpose of requesting a joint assignment under the DoDEA Transfer Program, affirm by our signatures below that our domestic partnership complies with the definition and criteria set forth above and that all information we have provided on this affidavit is accurate, and we agree to notify DoDEA Human Resources within thirty (30) days if the domestic partner relationship ends, or if there is a change in any of the information we have provided.

It is understood that my domestic partner will be held to the DoDEA standards of conduct that apply to family members. It is also understood that falsification of information within this affidavit may constitute a criminal violation under 18 U.S.C. and may lead to disciplinary actions and forfeit of any benefits.
